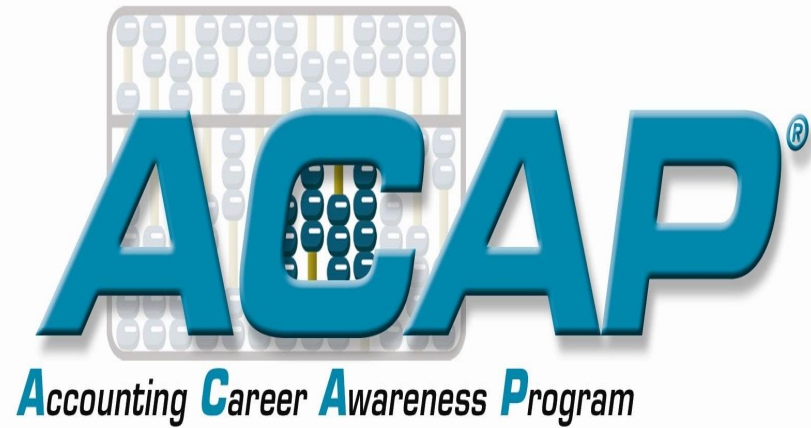

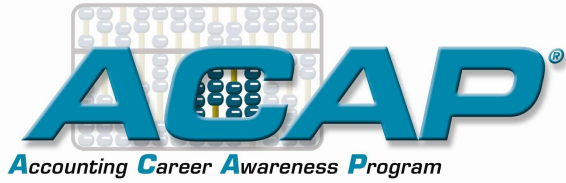

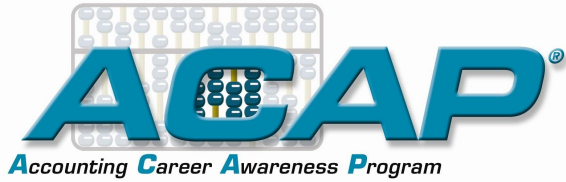

ACAP Expectations & Behaviors

- Read and respond to text, email, and phone call messages from ACAP Administrators and Counselors.

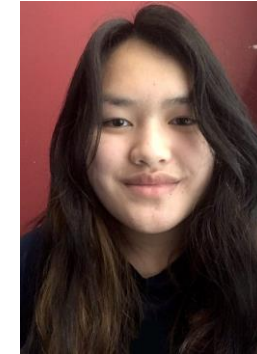

- Allows students to meet and interact with people who look like them and who are willing to share their experiences.



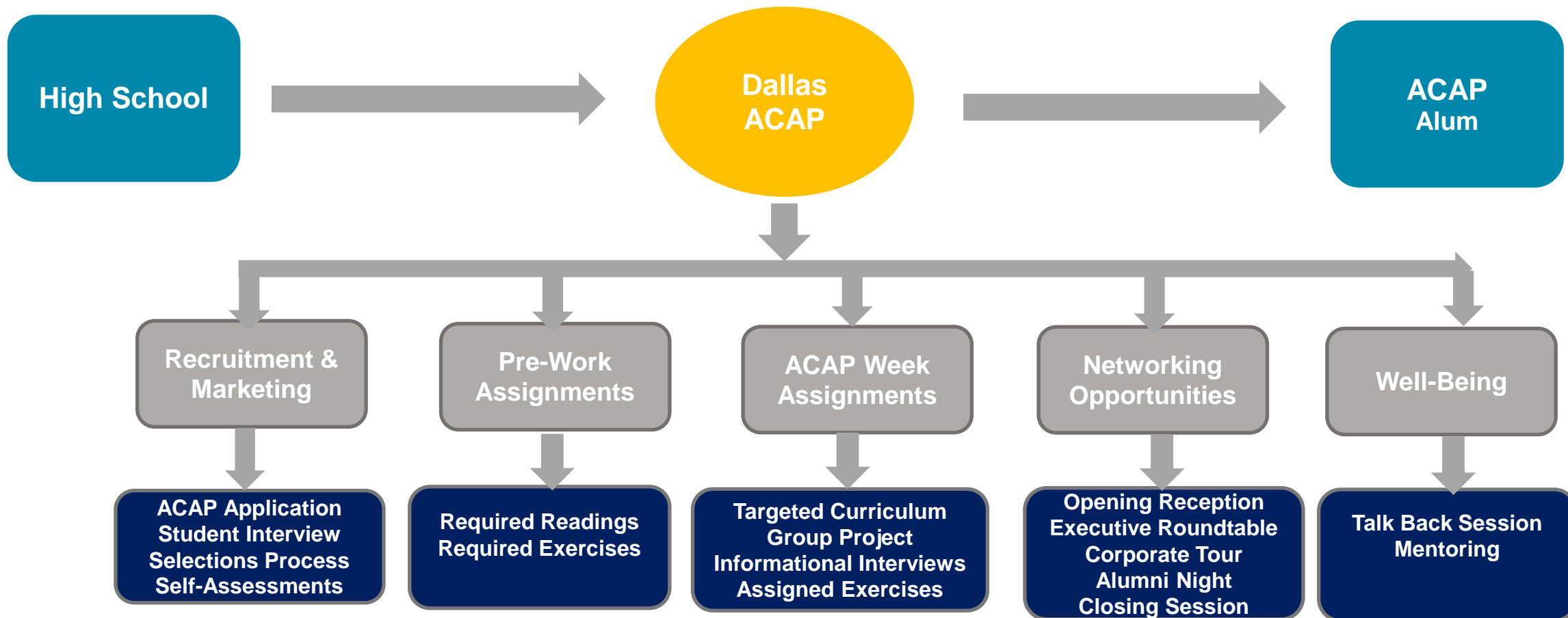
Personal Development

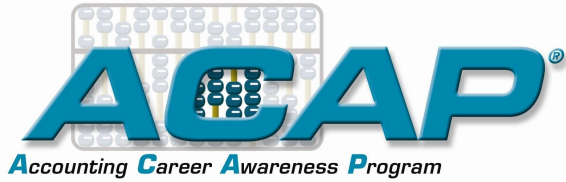

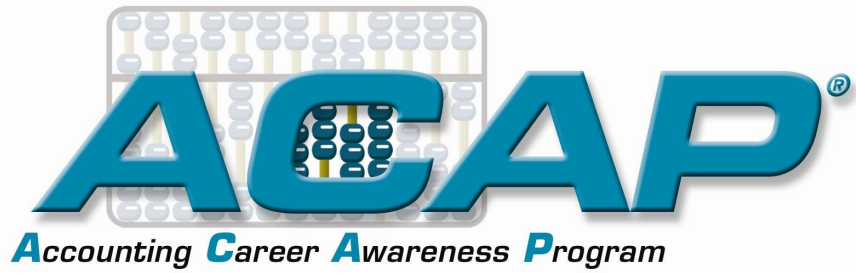
ACAP Scholarship Highlights

Offered only to those ACAP students who apply for the ACAP Scholarships, complete ACAP Week, and satisfactorily completes the required assignments.

Scholarship Eligibility:

- Satisfies ACAP admissions requirements
- Submits 500-word essay
- Submits to an Interview

Scoring Rubric	
Area	# Points
Character, Leadership & Service	20 points
Satisfies Admissions Requirements	15 points
500-Word Essay	30 points
Satisfactory Completion of Assignments	20 points
Scholarship Interview (Zoom)	15 points
Total	100 points
